

# Other Services For Foreign Residents

### Nishitokyo Multicultural Center

The center provides you consultation for daily matters. Open from Monday to Friday, from 10am to 12pm, and from 1pm to 4pm. Located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of ING Building, next to Nishi Tokyo City Hall Tanashi branch office.

#### <u>Japanese Language Class</u>

Nishitokyo City offers 11 Japanese language classes conducted by several volunteer groups. The classes are open from Monday to Saturday, and the time varies from each class. Please look at the yellow leaflet of "Japanese Language Classes" and call the class you are interested in.

### <u>Information on City Living</u>

The monthly leaflet about the city information is provided in simplified Japanese, English, Chinese, and Korean. It is issued on the 5<sup>th</sup> of every month. You can get it at the city hall, community center (Kominkan), library, and NIMIC.

### Interpretation Services

You can ask for an interpreter when you go to the city hall, or city-related places. Reservation is necessary. Call Nishitokyo Multicultural Center at least two weeks prior to the day you would like interpreting assistance.

## Consultation with Specialists

The city offers a free consultation event on December every year for foreign residents. Lawyers and specialists are there to assist you with legal, administrative, and home-related matters. Popular consultation issues include visa status, international marriage, and employment. Feel free to come to talk to the specialists for consultation!
